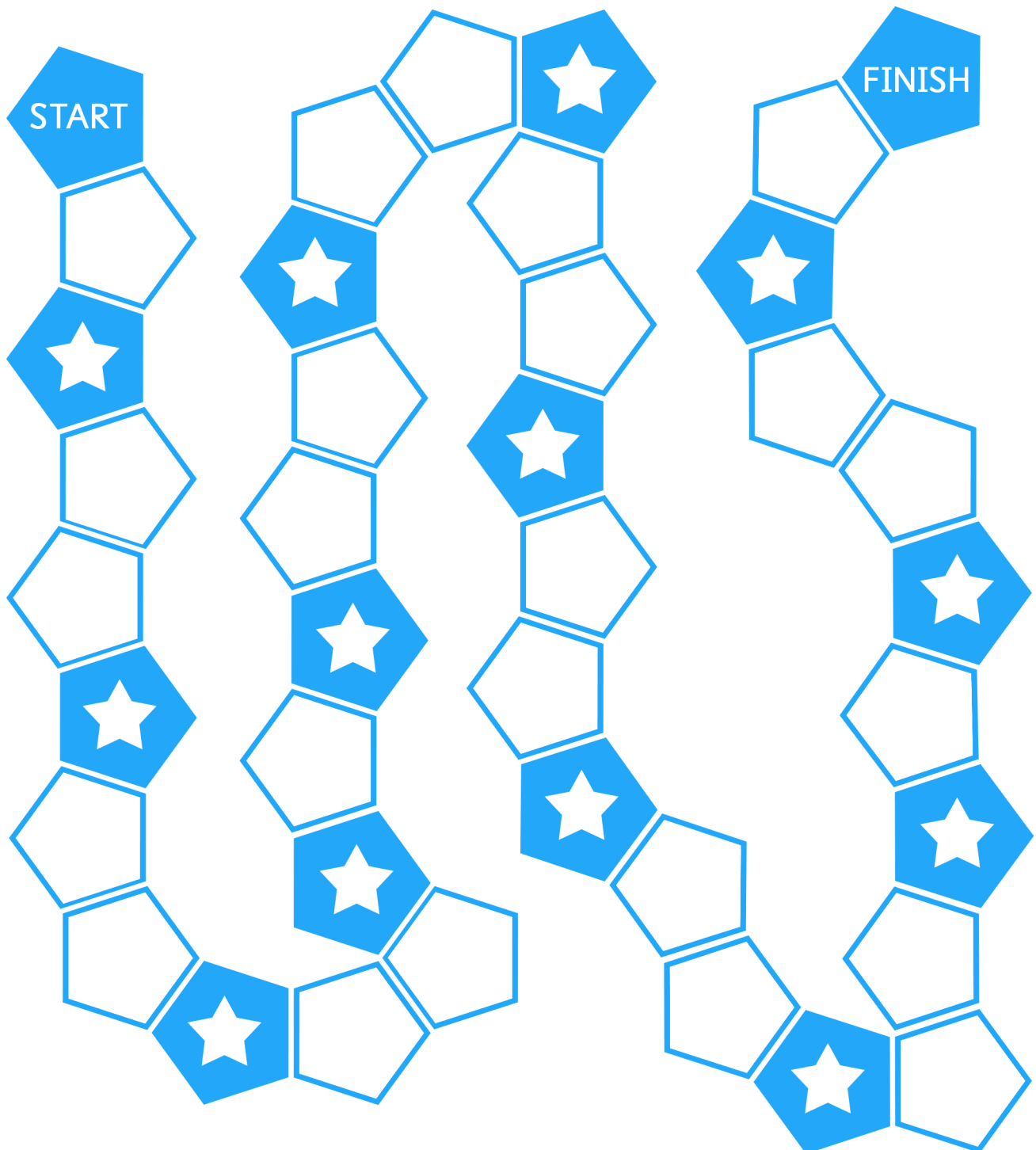


Spelling Game

Instructions – A game for 2 players.

Equipment – One laminated board game, 2 counters, one dice and a pack of the attached spelling cards (these need to be cut up, spread out and facing down so neither player can see the words until they are needed).

How To Play - Players take in turns to roll the dice. If a player lands on a 'star' spot, they must be tested on one of the spellings by the opposing player. The opposing player chooses a word card of their choice and reads out the word. If the speller gets the spelling right, they can roll on their next turn. If the player get the spelling wrong, they must write the word out correctly 5 times and miss a turn.
