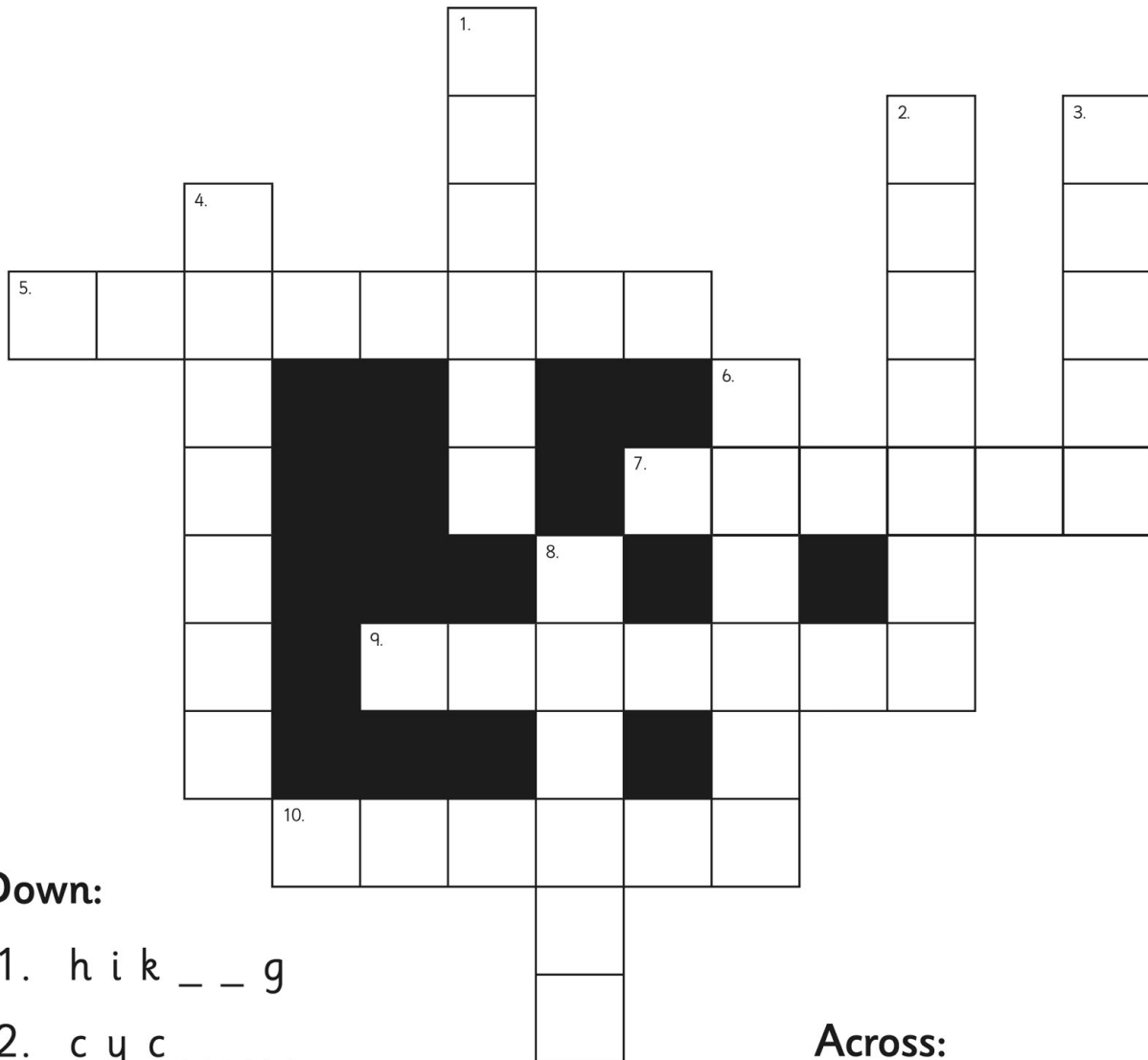

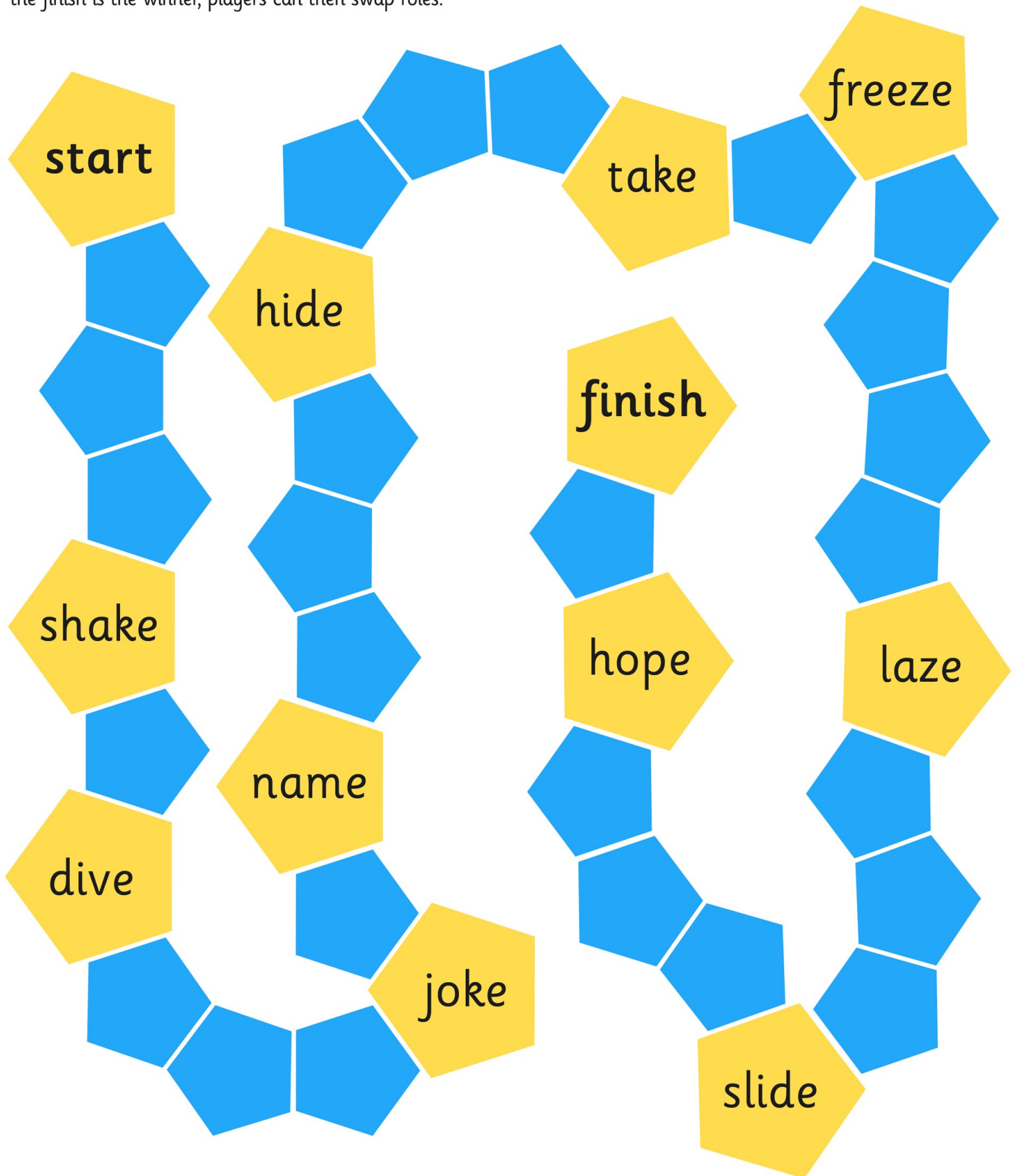

# Adding 'ing' Spelling Game

**Instructions:** A game for 3 players – 2 players and 1 grammar checker. Each player takes turns to roll a die. If a player lands on a word square they must add 'ing' to the word, writing down the new spelling for the checker. The grammar checker's job is to check to see if the spelling is correct. If the spelling is right, the player may take their next turn on their next roll. If the spelling is wrong, they must miss a turn and write the correct spelling 3 times. The first to the finish is the winner, players can then swap roles.
