Each week choose one different task from the list.
Home learning is due on a **Monday**.

Who is your favourite author? Write a list of the books you like to read and why you enjoy reading them.

Complete a book review of a recent book you have read.

Create an 'Amazing Adjectives' poster for some NEW words that you might like to try and use in your writing.

Design a poster on how to survive the Stone Age. What skills will you need? Which tools will you need?

Make a story map for the journey over time that your pebble has made. Where did it come from? Did a dinosaur stand on it? Did a scavenger or settler use it?

Create an attractive poster with words that mean the same as +, -, x and dividing
e.g. + add, sum, altogether etc. Present it in an imaginative way.

From newspapers/magazines cut out pictures of 2D shapes (eg circular clock etc) to make colourful pictures.

Choose a times table and create an eye-catching poster to help children learn their times tables.

Make a game that involves numbers. Include instructions as you may have to play it with someone else. You could also include mathematical operations like $+$ $-$ x

Write a character profile for one of the characters from the story of Rama and Sita.

Design your own cave painting.

Compare and contrast what you eat now and what people used to eat a long time ago. Present it in an imaginative way.

If you were an early human how would your costume look? Design and label your own winter costume.
