Dear Parents and Carers,

You will now have read the letter regarding surge testing by Public Health England in the Park Hill Junior School field car park from Tuesday 8th (tomorrow) – Monday 14th June.

Public Health England will be offering testing at school for all pupils and their households, and school staff **without symptoms.** The Mobile Testing Unit will be open for testing daily from 8:30am until 7:30pm Monday to Friday, and 9am until 3pm at the weekend. Below is a suggested schedule for families to avoid congestion and to ensure that social distancing can be maintained at all times.

During school hours, parents will need to collect their child from the Infant/Junior school office and accompany them for testing. Family members can get tested at the same time. Siblings may attend the same session. After testing, your child should return to school and does not need to isolate after the test, providing they do not display any symptoms. We will be waiving any late marks during this period of surge testing. E.g. if you test your child at 9.45am and subsequently drop your child to school, they will not be considered late. If you have been allocated an afternoon slot and prefer to do the test at the end of the day, you may collect your child slightly earlier from the school office.
