We have had another wonderful half term in Year 3 with all of our amazing learners. There is lots to share with our trips to the Hindu temple and our new outdoor learning experiences.

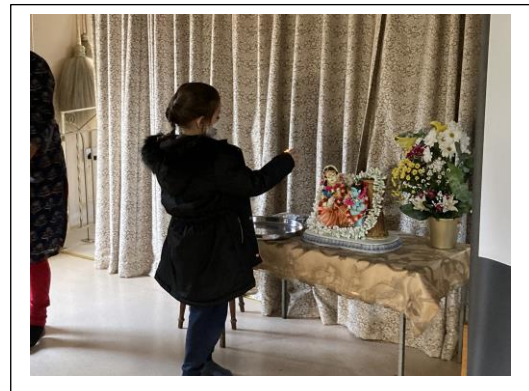
We hope that you have time this holiday to curl up together with some hot chocolate and let your child share the experiences they have enjoyed this half term at PHJS.

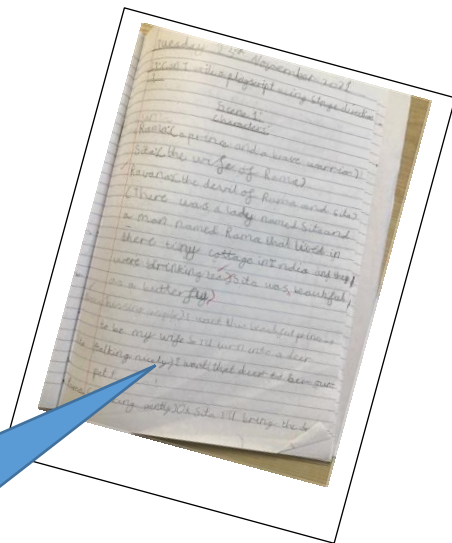
The Hindu Temple

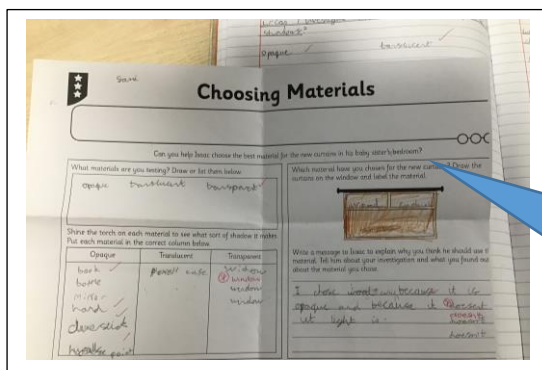


Writing, Geography, History and Science

for our puppet show.



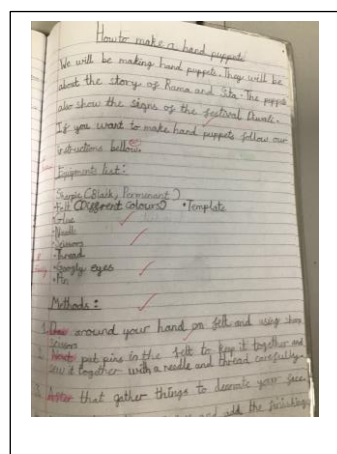
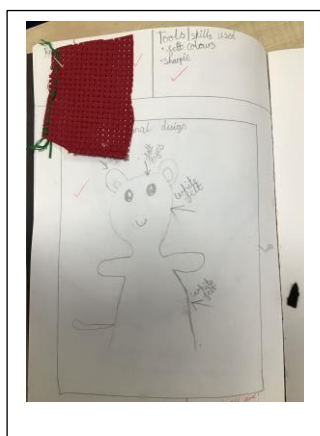
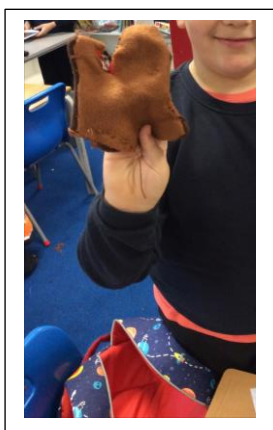
We have been experimenting with light and investigating the meaning of the words transparent, translucent and opaque.
