Our school is taking part in **One Kind Word Week (Anti-Bullying Week)** this term between **Monday 15th and Thursday 18th November 2021**. Anti-Bullying Week helps schools across England to shine a spotlight on bullying and encourage all children, teachers and parents to take action against bullying throughout the year.
