Wordships Spelling Game

Game instructions

A game for 2 players. Each player needs a laminated game board and a whiteboard pen. Before the game can begin, each player must secretly choose 10 rectangles in which to write the 10 spelling words or 'wordships'. This week's spellings – especially, exaggerate, exaggerated, exaggeration, excellent, excellence, excel, excelled, existence, explanation. Players take it in turns to give co-ordinates. Player 1 begins by giving player 2 a co-ordinate, e.g B4. If this co-ordinate finds a 'wordship' on player 2's board, player 2 must say the word and player 1 must spell it correctly. If player 1 spells the word correctly, they sink player 2's 'wordship' (player 2 puts a cross over the word) however if the spelling is incorrect, the 'wordship' doesn't need to be crossed and remains afloat for another turn. The aim of the game is to sink all the opposing player's 'wordships'.

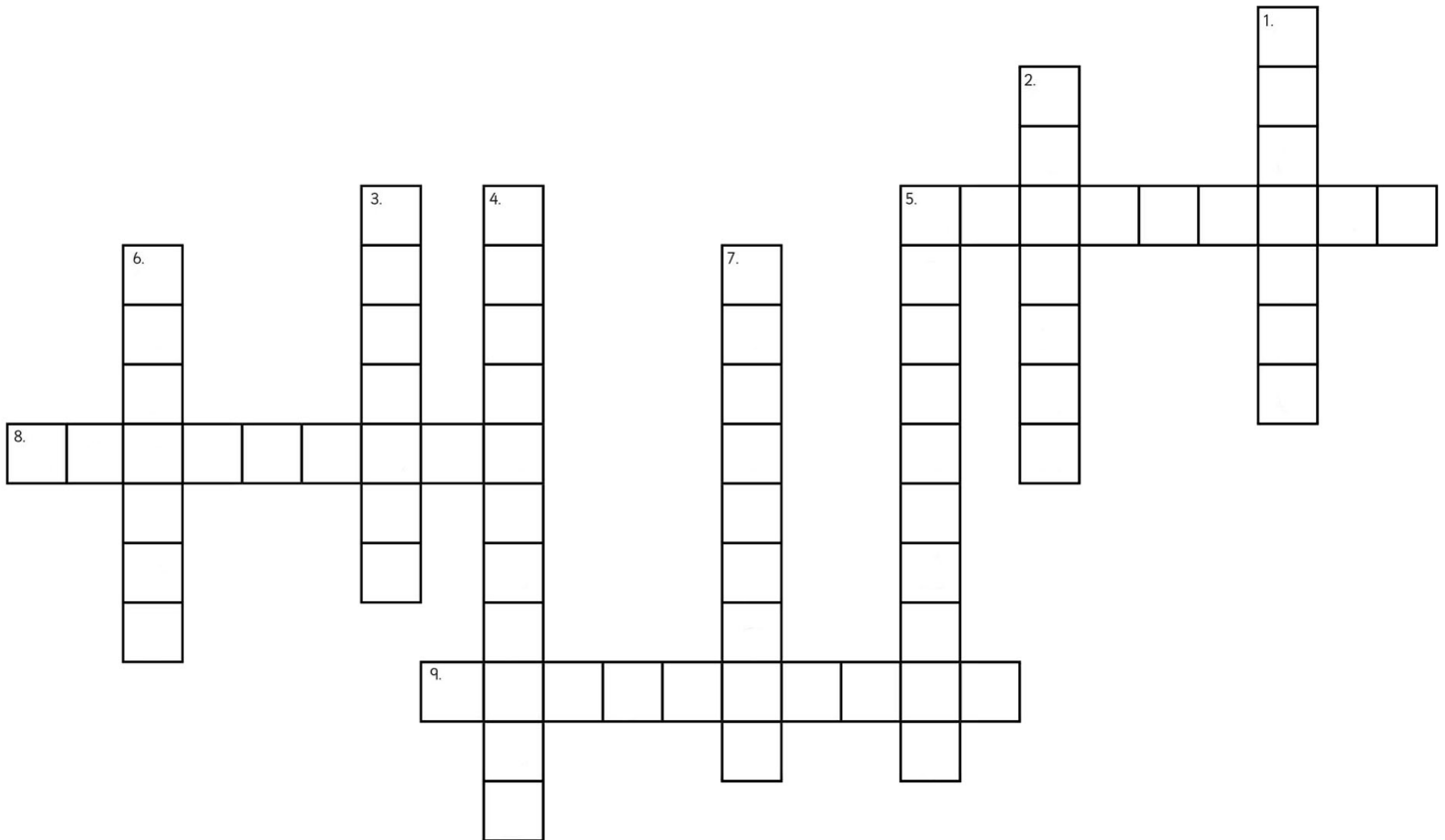
