



What is the Park Hill Schools' Association (PHSA)?

The Park Hill Schools' School Association is a registered charity (Registered Charity Number 288263) which aims to:

- Raise funds to enhance the children's development and enjoyment at the Park Hill Infants and Junior schools.
- Encourage a positive link between parents and the schools.
- Create social activities for children, parents and teachers.

As parents and carers of children at Park Hill Infants and Juniors, you are automatically members of Park Hill Schools' Association (PHSA).

Our 4 key events are:

- **Summer Fair (July)**
- **Fireworks Display (November)**
- **Christmas Fair (December)**
- **Family Bingo Night and AGM (March)**

We also have smaller events such as the after school **Playground Snack Shop** and **Bag2School/Genie Recycling** and **servicing refreshments during the schools Sports Days and the Infants May Country Dancing**. These events may only require your help for 30 minutes once a term!

Please show your support by attending one of our coffee mornings and finding out how you can get involved. By each of us contributing a little time and talent we can make a huge difference to our children.

What are we raising funds for?

Park Hill Infants:

- In 2018, the money raised by the PHSA will be used towards specialist artists to work with children on a mural in Reception area, a Bug Hotel, a whole school art exhibition and specialist art teacher.
- In 2017, the PHSA funds contributed towards: a sensory den, refurbishment of Reception and Year 1 foyer, EYFS outdoor equipment, Jigsaw PSHE resources, Fairy Worry Plaques and Worry Monsters.
- In previous years the PHSA funds contributed towards a Greenhouse, a Tropical Fish tank, playground refurbishment, the outdoor learning space and gardening area by the reception classrooms, apparatus to improve core and upper arm strength, a new race track with a zebra crossing, traffic lights and traffic signs to raise awareness of road safety and a public address system, a new library, school hall flooring and resourcing cooking equipment.

Park Hill Juniors:

- The PHSA is now raising money to be used towards Phase 3 of the Junior school Playground Improvement Project which will begin next year. The project will create more space for outdoor play and discovery for our children.
- The money donated to the Junior school was last year used for the Second Phase of the Playground Improvement project: 2nd tyre park, 4 new benches, chess board, Roman numeral hopscotch and compass markings and outdoor stage were installed.

These Playground improvements have been put in place to promote the children's independence, confidence, self-esteem, interpersonal and social skills.
